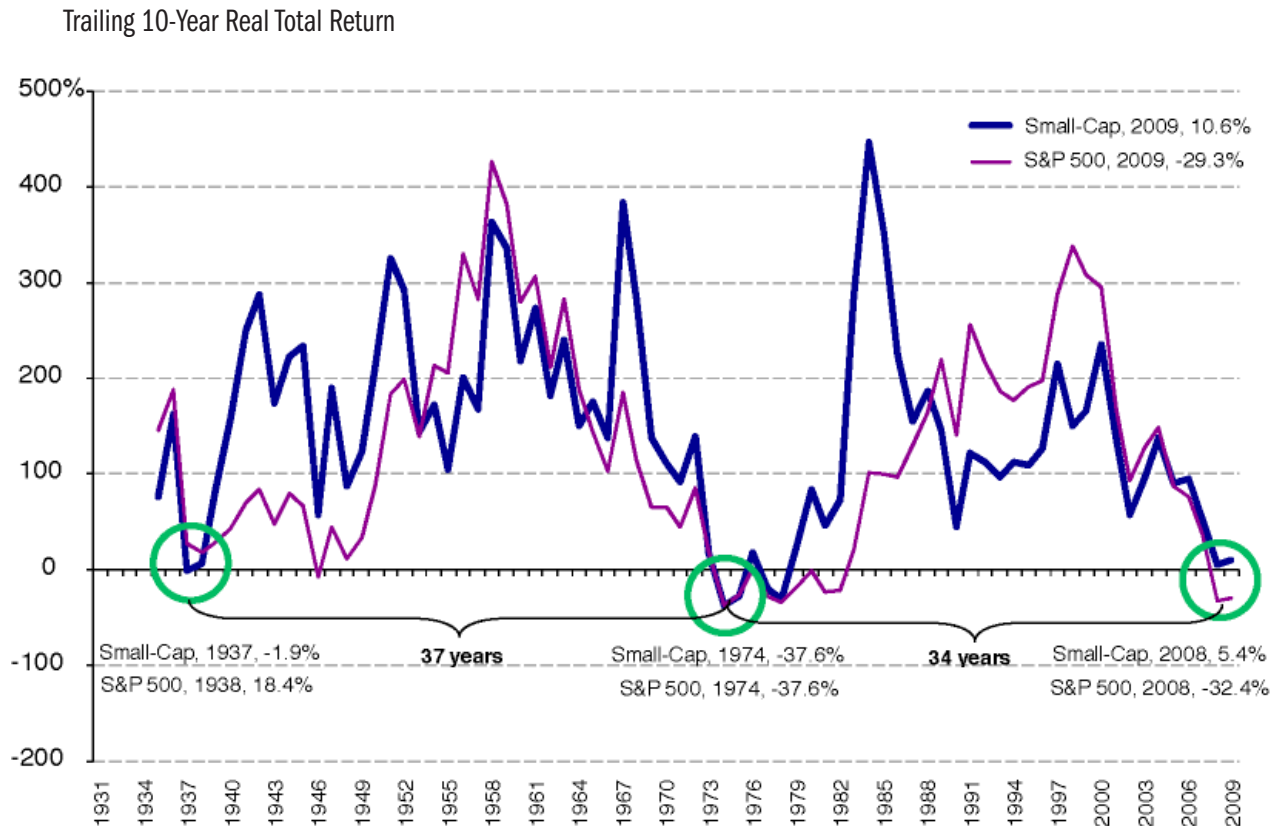


## Good Time to be Hunting for Great Values?
